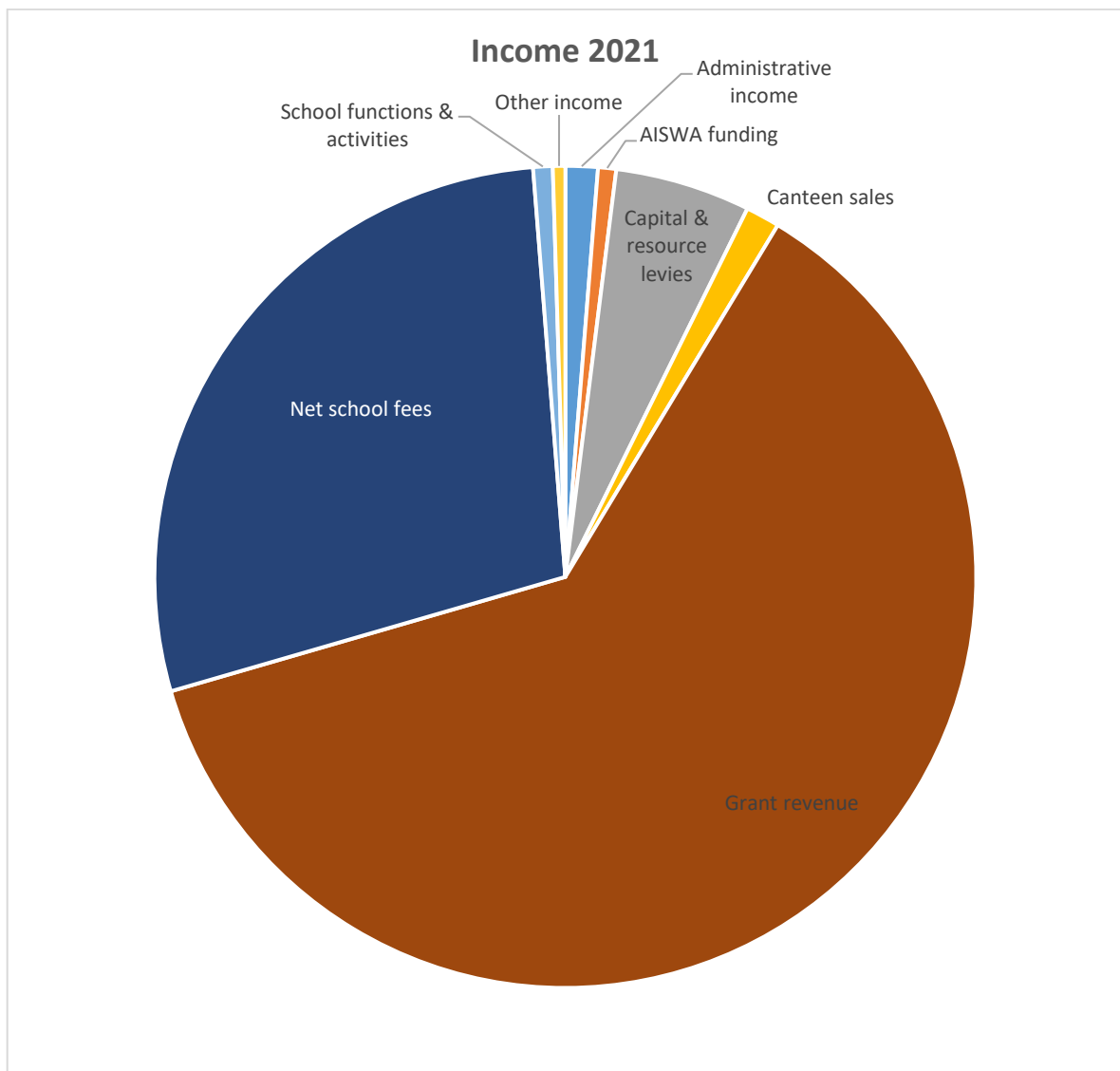
Year 12 results 2021

Student results were as predicted for their capacities within the subject choices they made. The highest Year 12 result for 2021 was 89.85.

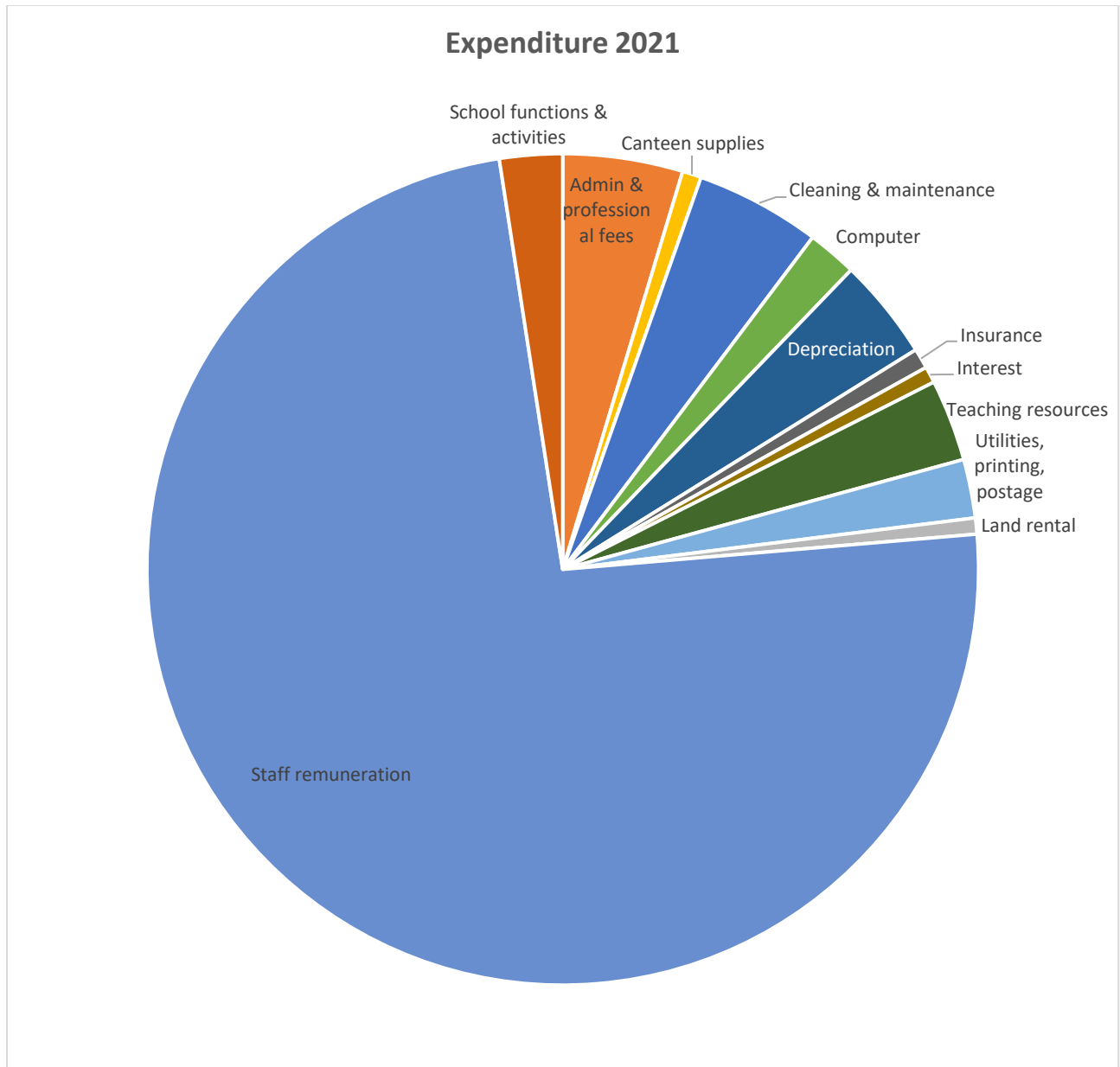
