

CODICIL TO YOUR WILL

Adding a clause to an existing Will

- 1. You should discuss any changes to your existing Will with your solicitor it is often better to make a new Will particularly if the changes you propose are substantial.
- 2. A Codicil is however convenient if you wish to make a gift of money or an asset to the Foundation set out below is an example where the testator wishes to leave a gift of money.
- 3. It is important that the Codicil is kept with your original Will after execution.

EXAMPLE FORM OF CODICIL

In all other respects I confirm the provisions of my said Will SIGNED by the testator in our presence and witnessed by us in the presence of each other and the testator named above.
