

INCLDUING A GIFT IN YOUR WILL

Wording Alternatives

To ensure your Will fulfils your intentions and is a legally sound document, it is essential that it be drawn up by a solicitor or Trustee Company.

The following are some wording alternatives that can be used as the basis for discussion with your solicitor.

Option 1: A portion or percentage of your estate:
I bequeath to St Andrew's Grammar School / St Andrew's Grammar School Foundation of 2 Hellenic Drive, Dianella WA 6059
 □ My whole estate, OR □ The residue of my estate, OR □ % of the residue of my estate upon trust to pay the same to the credit of St Andrew's Grammar School / St Andrew's Grammar School Foundation and I direct that the receipt of the Secretary, Treasurer or other proper officer of the School shall be a sufficient discharge to my executor.
I wish my bequest to be directed towards:

Option 2 – A specific dollar amount:
I bequeath to St Andrew's Grammar School / St Andrew's Grammar School Foundation of 2 Hellenic Drive, Dianella WA 6059 the sum of \$, upon trust to pay the same to the credit of the St Andrew's Grammar School / St Andrew's Grammar School Foundation and I direct that the receipt of the Secretary, Treasurer or other proper officer of the School shall be a sufficient discharge to my executor.
