# ST ANDREW'S GRAMMAR

## **School Uniform**

#### POLICY STATEMENT

St Andrew's Grammar has a conservative school uniform that reflects the values, ethos and Greek traditions of the School.

All students are expected to be dressed in the appropriate uniform for the season, term or event as outlined in the procedures below. We ask that all parents and guardians support the School by ensuring that their child is correctly dressed for school in the appropriate uniform of the day. Students are also expected to abide by all dress requirements with regards to personal grooming standards. Students are expected to ensure that their dress and appearance brings credit to the School and themselves. Failure to do so will result in the imposition of sanctions up to and including suspension from school until the matter is rectified.

#### **NOTES:**

Girls may choose to wear a plain hijab in the blue school colour. However, a hat must still be worn for sports, recess and lunch.

- 1. School shoes must have a heel of less than 3cm high.
- 2. Year 7 12: The School blazer to be worn with the summer uniform on formal occasions.
- 3. Year 7 12: Senior School hat to be worn for outdoor formal occasions. Compulsory for 2024 and beyond.
- 4. Year 7 12: Blazer is worn daily as part of the winter uniform and on all formal occasions.
- 5. School scarf not to be worm at formal occasions.

#### **SPORTSWEAR**

## Primary Kindergarten – Year 6 Boys and Girls

White Polo shirt with the School crest
Royal blue sports shorts with the School name
White sports socks with School stripe
School track jacket and track pant
A suitable track shoe that is **predominantly** white
House Polo shirt
School bucket hat

### Secondary Year 7 – Year 12 Boys and Girls

Royal Polo unisex or female fit shirt
Sports shorts (unisex and female fit); sport skirt (girls)
White sports socks with School stripe
School track jacket and track pant
A suitable track shoe that is **predominantly** white
House Polo shirt
School baseball cap

#### NOTE:

All students are permitted to wear their House Polo shirt with the School crest and House name at House carnivals and on other approved occasions.

#### **Head Wear**

**All** children are required to have a St Andrew's Grammar hat for sports, recess and lunch. The hat is as stipulated in the uniform rules above. Non-standard hats including those with advertising logos are not permitted.

Girls from Years 1-12 who choose to wear a plain Hijab in the blue school colour may do so. However, a hat must still be worn for sports, recess and lunch.

## **Dress Regulations**

- All uniform items mentioned above need to be school branded uniform items which are available at the school uniform shop (excluding shoes)
- Summer uniform is worn in Term 1 and 4.
- Winter uniform is worn in Term 2 and 3.
- There is a two week transition period at the beginning of Tern 2, to accommodate warm weather.
- Students are expected to ensure that their dress and appearance brings credit to the School and themselves.
- School shirts (boys) must be tucked in on all occasions.
- Long sleeved shirts and jumpers are not permitted to be rolled up.
- Hem length of skirts and pinafore dresses to be no shorter than at the middle of the knee.
- Top button of shirts to be done up when wearing a tie.

- Black lace-up school shoes heel height maximum 3cm.
- Black leather joggers (sport shoes) are not permitted as school shoes.
- Sport shoes (track shoes) are to be predominantly white in colour.
- School hats are required to be worn at recess, lunch and sport.
- Only St Andrew's Grammar School bags may be used at the School.
- Hair accessories must be navy, white or royal blue.
- Girls' hair must be off the face and, if of collar length or longer, must be tied up.
- Boys' hair must be off the face and, if of collar length or longer, must be tied up.
- Dyeing of hair and extreme hairstyles are not permitted.
- Excessive amounts of gel or wax should not be placed in the hair.
- Boys are expected to be cleanly shaved at all times.
- Boys may only wear a single stud earring in the loxer lower lobe of one ear but are in general
  discouraged from ear piercings. Girls may wear one pair of plain ear studs or plain sleeper earrings
  in the lower lobe of each ear and in no other part of the ear. Any other form of piercing or jewellery
  is not permissible.
- Nails are not permitted to extend beyond the fingertip. Nail polish and make-up are not permitted.
- Optional jewellery includes a watch and a chain (gold or silver). A cross or religious medallion chain must not be visible. Students of the Christian Orthodox faith may wear a single black prayer rope bracelet.

Any deviation from this policy must be agreed in writing by the Principal, Chair of the School Board from time to time.
