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# **WHAT IS A CCA?**

Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) are defined as activities that complement and enhance the academic, cultural, artistic and athletic experiences of the school's current curriculum.

The staff at St Andrew's Grammar are committed to giving students a holistic learning experience. We provide an abundance of opportunities and choices to trial different interests and to build students' social relationships outside the classroom.

What are the benefits?

A fully engaging co-curricular program will enhance the students' pursuit of success in a well-rounded schooling environment. Our CCAs seek to develop and nurture resilience and self-esteem in students, cultivated within a safe space that students enjoy.

According to the Australian Council of Education Research (ACER), some students struggle because of a poor sense of belonging.

The CCAs are designed to counteract some of the social challenges by providing activities that support peer-to-peer comradery, opportunities for teamwork, and a strong sense of community.

# The CCAs help students:

- collaborate with one another
- develop leadership qualities
- · transfer their skills into the classroom
- build stronger relationships with teachers and students outside the classroom

# Student-led inquiry:

Students have full ownership of their CCA options. They get to map out their Cocurricular choices based on their own personal interests and goals. This creates a level of safety and freedom for students to fully immerse themselves into an activity of their choosing, experience a greater sense of autonomy, and learn at their own pace.

# *How does it work?*

To register successfully for CCAs, there's a few things to note:

- 1. CCAs start in Week 3 of each term.
- 2. Register via the Consent2Go link that's been emailed to you
- 3. Students are only eligible for the Year cohort they are in.
- 4. Some CCAs have maximum numbers, so get in quick!
- 5. Some CCAs require payment. So, if there is a maximum on numbers, you have to pay to be counted and eligible.


