We are a K-12 co-educational Independent School in Dianella of 730 students with around 80 teaching staff and we are Western Australia's only Greek Orthodox school. With a small, yet growing, percentage of Greek students, the school has had incredible growth in recent years moving from 387 students in 2019 to over 770 in 2024. The cultural diversity amongst the student population is an enriching aspect of the school fostering respect for all people. We are a Grammar school with an emphasis on high academic standards, our NAPLAN and ATAR results are testament to this. "We offer learning pathways for opportunity and success, as we nurture the social and emotional wellbeing of every student."

- Prepare and deliver timely and targeted feedback and reports to students and parents.

Pastoral Care

Actively participate in pastoral care and wellbeing programs and other cocurricular activities. Some cocurricular activities will occur outside normal school hours. Communicate with students, colleagues and parents/guardians in a respectful, clear, caring and professional manner.

- Participate in school functions including Speech Night and Parent Teacher evenings.
- Carry out supervisory duties as required.
- Engage in professional reading and development as part of an expectation of continual professional learning.
- Participate in department meetings and whole staff meetings. Some of these occur outside of normal school hours.
- Participate in the Co-curricular Program of the school.
- Participate in Greek related activities and social events.
- Abide by the staff Code of Conduct and other School policies.

- A bachelor's in education or equivalent.
- A relevant undergraduate degree and teaching qualifications.
- Must be a Qualified teacher with at least 2 years teaching experience.
- Teachers Registration.
- Working with Children's check or ability to obtain one.

- Fluent in English and Greek
